RLL COACH'S CORNER:

Rumford Summer Sandlot: "You're killing me Smalls"

As June comes to a close, so does the spring Little League season. School ends for the summer and the early summer days stretch into the late evening hours. To us at RLL, that is an invitation to play more baseball.

This year we are introducing our Summer Sandlot Series! The Summer Sandlot is open to any player Little League Age 8-11, who played in RLL during the spring season. The sessions will take place weeknights between July 5 and July 31, when the field and coaches are available to make it happen.

Here is how it works:

- Email Coach Sam at sbazar41@gmail.com if your player is interested in participating.
- 2 You will be invited to a GameChanger team called Rumford Summer Sandlot.
- 3 Session dates/times will be posted in GameChanger and notifications will be sent out through the app.
- 4 If your player is interested in playing in that session, RSVP that the player is attending.
- 5 Show up and play.

The teams will be made at the beginning of each session. The games will be fast paced. A coach will pitch the scrimmages to allow the game to move quickly without walks or delays. Players will get plenty of at bats, with plenty of strikes to swing at. The coach may pitch faster or slower as is appropriate depending on the participants. Catchers may be used, and stealing may be implemented. That decision will be made at the beginning of each session. The scrimmages may take on a two-team format or a three-team format at the coach's discretion depending on attendance and abilities of the players at each session.

- There are no uniforms.
- There are no set teams.
- The games are competitive but there are no standings.
- There are no umpires or base coaches.
