Hi Rumford Little League Families!

We have some great news for getting our season started.

Beginning on June 1st, our older divisions (Seniors, Juniors, Majors and Minors) will begin practicing.

Tee ball and Farm divisions are currently delayed and will be reevaluated at the beginning of the Governors Phase 3 Reopening RI plan. (https://www.reopeningri.com)

We have put together a plan that meets all state and city requirements and modeled by the CDC recommendations.

There will be changes to how we normally operate, with some responsibilities being on the parents/guardians that are summarized below:

- Parents will be required to register (Free) on our newly redesigned website (rumfordll.com) and accept the policies and waiver. (There is obviously no fee associated with this).
- All players must have their own equipment (Helmet, Bat, Glove, etc)
 - If you are not able to acquire any of these please let your coach know and we will work with you to get what you need.
- Players will not be allowed to chew gum or sunflower seeds during games and practices.
- Parents will be required to fill out a Questionnaire form (in Digital form) prior to <u>ALL</u> practices and games.
 - The coaches will be able to see the results from the Questionnaire in realtime and will not allow a child to play if the form is not completed.
